1ST JANUARY 2006

I enjoyed my day judging for the Northern Boxer Club. The committee worked hard as always, to run a well organised show with a great atmosphere. Thank you to my two gorgeous young ladies for their excellent stewarding skills and for keeping the ring (and myself) in such good order. I had a good entry to go over although fronts, shoulders and upper arms were appalling. Mouths were a bit worrying and some lacked sound rear movement with drive. On the promising side, some lovely balanced outlines, nice feet, bone and substance. Some good heads although some were spoiled with too much wrinkle. All were very well presented.

MBP (5,1) 1. DRINKWATER'S SULEZ SHORENUFF. Lovely dark brindle that is well balanced in outline. Of excellent size and has good bone and substance. Crested neck to good topline, tailset and strong quarters. His head is just gorgeous with excellent width and depth all through. Lovely chin, excellent stop and rise of skull. Beautiful dark eye with an expression that would melt anyone's heart. He still has a lot of maturing to do and is as he should be for a puppy. Moved well going away and covered the ground going around. His outstanding quality made him stand out in the line-up and with his handlers excellent efforts as always in preparation and presentation I could not deny him the class, BPD, BD, BIS & BPIS. Well done one for the Upper House surely. 2. MELVILLE & GETHING'S JEDDHI YANKEE PASHA. Another nice puppy but not the size, substance and scope of 1. Well balanced in outline with a good topline. Head is well balanced with good width of muzzle, defined stop and good rise of skull. Lovely dark eye and expression. Preferred better front assembly and quarters of 1. 3. CAIRNS GALICAR INDECISION.

PD (6,3) 1. BEE'S NORWATCH SUNHAWK MAGIC SPELL AT BEEANN. Very promising 7 month old red. Looked so immature in this class but won through on his lovely quality. Very well balanced in outline, crested neck, good front and height in foreleg. Good topline, tailset and strong quarters. Lovely clean head with good width and depth all through. Defined stop and good rise of skull. Gorgeous eye and expression. A little excitable today on the move and standing. 2. PYNEGAR'S BERWYNFA GAME BOY. Substantial brindle & white. Well balanced in outline, Good topline and tailset. Tended to overstretch himself. Head was well balanced with good width of muzzle, defined stop and rise of skull. Would prefer less wrinkle. Preferred the scope of 1.

JD (7,1) 1. BELL & BEARDOW'S RENNLOU SIXTH SENSE VIA BELVERN. 1. Compact balanced dark brindle. Good size and substance and well off for bone. Good topline, tailset and quarters. Nicely balanced head with good depth. Defined stop and excellent rise of skull. Lovely dark eye and expression. Moved out well. Expertly handled as you would expect from this kennel. RBD. 2. WATSON'S ROYLARK BARNEY RUBBLE. A extremely well made red with great style. A real showman on his toes at all times. Beautifully balanced in body, lovely crested neck, good front and shoulder, good topline, tailset and strong quarters. Balanced head with good width and depth. Just preferred the expression and stop of 1. Well handled. 3. CHIPPENDALE'S MAN ON A MISSION FOR MYLICAM.

NOV. (3,1) 1. WATSON'S ROYLARK BARNEY RUBBLE. 2. BEARDSSELL & VAN BECK'S FAERDORN CONJUROR AT NEWLAITHE. Smart well balanced, good topline. Crested neck. Lovely head with good rise of skull. Well handled.

TYRO (3,0) 1. WATSON'S ROYLARK BARNEY RUBBLE. 2. BOOTH'S SELTAP DANNY DELIVER. Well made red that's well balanced in outline. Good topline and quarters. Good head with good width of muzzle. Nice eye & expression. 3. THORPE'S ROSEROYD STREETWISE AT BRULIZ.

PGD (2,0) 1.WATSON'S ROYLARK BARNEY RUBBLE. 2. FORKIN & GRIFFIN MULBRAE THE COMPOSER FOR SUBARASHII. Balanced brindle with good bone and substance. Good topline & quarters. Crested neck, clean head, dark eye.

LD (4,3) 1. BUCKLEY'S SHAKATAN ACE OF SPADES. Well made brindle of good size and with substance. Good topline and quarters. Crested neck, lovely head, clean through the skull, lovely eye and expression.

OD (2,1) 1.CLAYFORTH'S TYSLEE TWIST OF FATE. Lovely headed dark brindle that is balanced in outline. Excellent size & substance. Good topline and quarters. His head is clean with good width and depth all through. Defined stop and good rise of skull. Lovely eye and expression. Moved well and expertly handled.

MPB (9,2) A lovely class of puppy bitches that will I'm sure change places many times. 1.COOK'S MANIC SCANDALOUS RUMOUR. V. smart & v stylish dark brindle of good size, with an exceptionally balanced outline. Lovely feminine head just right for age and not overdone in any way. Good width and depth of muzzle. Stop and rise of skull developing nicely. Lovely eye and expression. Long crested neck, into good firm topline, bang on tailset with strong quarters. Good width through second thigh, correct angulation behind with strong hocks. Moved well when she settled. Would just prefer better lay of shoulder. Expertly handled, and excellent presentation as you would expect from this kennel. Has bags of scope and I'm sure will get even better as she matures. Her style and outstanding quality gained her Res. BB in a good bitch line up & BPB. 2. HALL'S MIQLUM SEZ CAN DO. Another promising puppy. More together than 1. Balanced in outline. Crested neck, good topline, tailset and quarters. Good front, with pronounced chest, good layback of shoulder and length of upper arm. V pretty clean head with defined stop and good rise of skull. Just preferred the width of muzzle, and squarer outline of 1. 3. BEARDSELL & VAN BECK'S NEWLAITHE HOT HEELS.

PB (4,3) 1.WATERWORTH'S BARWATER IFYA MIGHT. Well balanced red of good size. Good topline & quarters. Crested neck. Clean well balanced head with lovely dark eye and expression. Well handled.

JB (10,4) 1.PYNEGAR'S BERWYNFA SUGAR BABE JW. Ultra smart golden brindle of excellent size. Beautifully balanced in outline, square with good depth through brisket. Arched neck, correct topline, short loin, good tailset and strong quarters. Good width of second thigh, strong hocks. Good front with pronounced chest, good lay and length of shoulder. Well placed and high set withers. Her head is of good proportions, with excellent width and depth all through. Lovely defined stop, good rise over skull. Beautiful eye and expression. Just would prefer less wrinkle over skull. In sparkling condition, moved well in all directions and handled to perfection as you would expect from this kennel. BB in a lovely line up of bitches and RBIS. Well done. Surely one on the look out for many top honours. 2. AINSWORTH'S WALKON BAYWATER OF PARTHANE. Another very smart brindle but not quite as compact as 1. Very well made with a balanced outline. Good front, topline and quarters. Beautiful well balanced clean head. Good width of muzzle, defined stop, good rise of skull. Lovely eye and expression. Moved well. 3.CHIPPENDALE'S MAID TO MINGLE WITH MYLICAM.

NB (3,1) 1.FORKIN & GRIFFIN'S SISTER BLISS FROM KOPPERNOX. Good sized brindle. Good head, with good width of muzzle, defined stop and good rise of skull. Lovely eye and expression. Good front & topline. A little long-cast in body. Moved well when settled. 2. STOCKDALE'S MARBELTON BELLE OF THE BALL AT STOCKERBOX. More balanced than 1 in body and outline. Good topline & tailset. Strong quarters. Clean feminine head, would prefer more width of muzzle and preferred front of 1.

TB (4,2) 1. BRIDGEMAN'S MARBELTON MISS DIOR AT DIBRID. Very smart well balanced red of good size. V. square in outline, with a good front, shoulder & topline. Good tailset & quarters. Balanced head with excellent stop, & rise of skull. Would prefer longer muzzle. Showed beautifully and moved well. 2. WATERWORTH'S BARWATER VICAR OF DIBLEY. Smart brindle with a well balanced body. Good topline & quarters. Lovely head with clean skull. Carrying a little too much weight and gave her handler a hard time today.

PG (4,1) 1. Very smart red bitch of good size & substance. Very well balanced in outline, with arched neck, good topline, tailset and quarters. Lovely head with good width and depth of muzzle, defined stop with good rise of skull. Lovely eye and expression. Moved well in all directions. 2. DRINKWATER'S SULEZ CAPRICE. Much cobbier bitch than 1 with a lovely balanced outline. Good topline & quarters. Clean head, defined stop. Lovely eye and expression. Preferred overall balance & height of 1. 3. JACKSON'S VANECK DAIQUIRI AT KIRSANNA.

LB (3,1) 1. BEARDSSELL & VAN BECK'S NEWLAITHE JUST STUNNING.. Ultra smart red of excellent size and substance. Very well balanced in outline, good topline, tailset and quarters. Lovely arched neck. Lovely head with good stop & rise of skull. Moved well in all directions and handled to perfection. Pushed the winners hard. 2. WOOLLISS'S JINNYBRUX JUST A HINT AT RAMELEON. Heavier type of bitch to 1. Good topline & quarters, arched neck. Good head, lovely eye and expression.

OB (3,1) 1. PYNEGAR'S BERWYNFA FIT CHICK JW. Another very smart bitch from this kennel. Well balanced in outline, good topline & quarters. Good size and substance. Arched neck. Lovely head with good width & depth of muzzle, Lovely eye & expression and expertly handled. 2. WOOLLISS'S JINNYBRUX JUST A RUMOUR AT RAMELEON. Heavier type of bitch to 1. good front and length of upper arm. Well laid shoulders. Good topline. Good head with excellent well padded muzzle. Not settled today.
