THE NORTHERN BOXER CLUB RE-HOMING AND RESCUE INFORMATION

If you would like to re-home / adopt a Boxer this leaflet may help you

About Us

We are a Breed Club based in Yorkshire run by a small committee. All of our re-homing and rescue work is done voluntarily

We work closely with other Breed Clubs and Rescue Organisations to ensure that every Boxer who needs a new home is adopted as quickly as possible

Our areas are North, South and West Yorkshire

WE DO NOT BUY OR SELL DOGS NOR DO WE ACT AS AGENTS FOR BREEDERS

We do however ask for a £10.00 Registration Fee before we can add you to our Adoption Lists - this is to cover Administration costs

You will also be asked for a further fee of £140.00 on collection of your new Dog Please remember we run our Rescue voluntarily - all fees and funds raised from our Club are used for Kennelling costs, spaying/neutering etc

BEFORE APPLYING TO ADOPT PLEASE CONSIDER THE FOLLOWING:

- DO YOU HAVE THE TIME FOR A DOG - BOXERS ARE SOCIABLE DOGS AND DO NOT LIKE TO BE LEFT FOR MORE THAN 3-4 HOURS AT A TIME
- HAVE YOU GOT A SECURE GARDEN - BOXERS ARE VERY GOOD ESCAPE ARTISTS
- DOES EVERYONE IN THE FAMILY WANT A BOXER?
- HOW ARE YOUR OTHER PETS GOING TO REACT TO A NEW DOG?
- ARE YOU ABLE TO COVER FEEDING AND VETS COSTS- BOXERS COST AROUND £10.00 A WEEK TO FEED AND WHEN ILL VETS FES CAN BE COSTLY

THE NEXT STAGE IS TO FILL IN OUR APPLICATION FORM, THIS MAY BE DONE OVER THE PHONE WITH OUR CO-ORDINATOR, POSTED OR EMAILED/FAXED BACK TO US.

YOU WILL THEN BE CONTACTED WHEN A DOG BECOMES AVAILABLE AND ONE OF OUR COORDINATORS WILL BE ASKED TO ARRANGE A HOME CHECK
THE HOME SUITABILITY CHECK WILL ENSURE YOUR HOME AND GARDEN ARE SECURE AND WE WILL DISCUSS ALL ASPECTS OF BOXER AND RESCUE DOG OWNERSHIP

WHEN A SUITABLE DOG BECOMES AVAILABLE WE WILL CONTACT YOU AND YOU MAY HAVE TO TRAVEL TO A KENNEL TO VIEW A DOG OR WE MAY PUT YOU IN TOUCH WITH AN OWNER DIRECT, AS MANY BOXERS THESE DAYS ARE JUST VICTIMS OF DIVORCE ETC.

IF YOU DECIDE THIS IS THE DOG FOR YOU WILL BE ASKED FOR YOUR FURTHER DONATION AND YOU WILL BE GIVEN ANY INFORMATION WE HAVE ABOUT THE DOG.

WHEN YOU GET YOUR NEW DOG HOME WE RECOMMEND THE FOLLOWING :

- GIVE YOUR NEW DOG TIME TO SETTLE IN - NOT TOO MANY VISITORS IN THE FIRST FEW DAYS
- IF YOU KNOW WHAT THE DOG HAS BEEN FED ON STICK WITH IT FOR AT LEAST A FEW DAYS - INTRODUCE ANY NEW FOOD GRADUALLY
- NEVER EVER LEAVE A DOG ALONE WITH YOUNG CHILDREN - HOWEVER MUCH YOU THINK A DOG IS OK WITH CHILDREN IT SHOULD NEVER BE LEFT TO CHANCE
- INTRODUCE SLOWLY TO OTHER ANIMALS - YOUR OTHER PETS MAY NOT BE TOO KEEN AT FIRST TO ACCEPT A NEW ARRIVAL.

IMPORTANT OUR POLICIES

- **WE DO NOT BUY OR SELL DOGS OR ACT AS AGENTS FOR BREEDERS**
- **ALL DONATIONS ARE USED TO HELP OTHER BOXERS IN NEED**
- **WE WILL NEVER PUT A HEALTHY DOG TO SLEEP UNLESS IT POSES A DANGER TO SOCIETY**
- **WHILST THE NORTHERN BOXER CLUB DO OUR BEST TO SUPPLY TRUE AND CORRECT INFORMATION ABOUT ALL DOGS AND OWNERS, IT MUST BE APPRECIATED THAT WE CANNOT ACCEPT LIABILITY FOR INJURY, LOSS OR DAMAGE ARISING FROM SUCH INFORMATION.**
- **WE EXPECT ANY DOG WHO IS RE-HOMED TO BE SPAYED/ NEUTERED WITHIN 3 MONTHS OF RE-HOMING.**
