Adopting a Rescue Boxer

If you would like to offer a Rescued Boxer a new start in life, then this leaflet may help you. Most of the Rescues work very closely with their parent Boxer Clubs, but there are some very good "independents" as well.

The country is covered by a network of dedicated volunteers who put a lot of time and effort into re-homing unwanted Boxers. Dogs come into Rescue for a variety of reasons, the two most common are for marriage/relationship breakdowns or changes in working hours. However, we do occasionally receive cruelty cases as well.

Please remember, some of the dogs we encounter have not had the best start to life and may be rather naughty, but you can teach an old dog new tricks and it should not be too long before they start to behave as you would like, however no two dogs are alike and a lot of patience and understanding may be needed.

If you are interested in taking on a Rescue dog, please answer ALL the questions on this form.

You must be aware that it is very rare that any Boxer Rescue has puppies for re-homing, the average age that any Rescue receives is 3 years+, it is also unlikely that you would be considered for a dog if you have to leave him/her for longer than 3 - 4 hours per day. As more and more dogs come into Rescue with long tails you must be prepared to accept one.
