MPB 9 (1 Absentee)

1st Marshall-Curtis, Marcurt Made From Lust

Very smart puppy. Excellent head with dark pigment, lovely eye and a clean skull. Still very raw in body and needs to strengthen throughout but just as she should be for her age.

2nd Schofields, Koppernox Pop Princess

Dark brindle and white girl with a super head and mouth. Clean sharp outline with good bone and substance. Excellent temperament. Just needs to go up on the front to complete the picture. Sure these two will swap places many times.

3rd Wilkinsons, Marcurt Lust Is A Must For Wroxons

PB 6 (0 Abs)

1st Ward-Davies, Brown & Hutchings, Rebkai Tale Of Love For Winuwuk

G/B/W full of quality. Reminds me very much of Ch Winuwuk The Mistress. Her head and expression are melting. Elegant outline with good neck flowing into a level topline. True front with lovely bone and feet. Strong quarters, moves out so well for a puppy and put on a polished performance. BPB

2nd Breakspears Porth Pearl Essence

Tall bitch with plenty of style. Lovely head with correct eye, a clean skull and a good mouth. Presents a sharp outline, still needs to fill her frame but a very nice bitch.

3rd Banks Norwatch Sunhawk Spotlight

JB 19 (4 Abs)

This was a lovely class and was really splitting hairs

1st Cants Mananin Analyse This

Not one that has ever caught my eye from the ringside but I must say this bitch is a pleasure to judge. Very feminine with bags of style. Clean balanced head. Arched neck, firm level topline, correct quarters and good height on foreleg. Moves out well showing her socks off at all times. She kept on catching my eye to take this lovely class.

2nd Millers Roamaro First Issue By Walkon

Another girl full of style and quality. Excellent head with dark eyes and good muzzle. Needs more time to firm up as a bigger bitch than first but presents a very smart outline and moves well with good ground covering action. Sure she will go far.

3rd Groves & Hares Jimbren Top Shelf

YB 13 (5 Abs)

1st Carters Susancar Courtney Act JW

Gave this bitch Best Puppy in Sweepstakes last year and thought she was lovely and my opinion has not changed. She is maturing well and is very sound throughout. Her head and expression won her this class. Balanced square outline, strong quarters and a good mover. Just needs to carry a little less weight to complete the picture.

2nd Carnabys Faerdorn Dusted Over Tartarian

Very different in type to 1st but still a quality bitch. Has the sharpest of outlines with so much style. Excellent bone and substance yet retains her femininity. Pleasing head and good mouth. Moves very well. Once she reaches full maturity I'm she will make it to the top.

3rd Pynegars Berwynfa G Spot

NB 12 (2 Abs)

Headed by litter sisters.

1st Boardman & Dawsons Walkon Tantrums N Tiaras At Bonobo

Very feminine mahogany brindle. Pretty head which still needs to develop in muzzle to complete but given her age I'm sure this will come in time. Shapely outline that flows from top to tail. Moved and handled well, shown in good hard condition.

2nd Millers Walkon Bunny Hugger

A stronger bitch than her sister but full of quality. Lovely head with dark expressive eyes. Very well made throughout and moves well. I gave their sire his 2nd CC when I last judged and it is good to see that he is passing on his excellent type in his offspring.

3rd Cants Bartlans Eva Green At Mananin

DB 8 (3 Abs)

Found it hard to split the first 3. Wished I could have had 3 first prize cards.

1st Gilmores Sandyne Exotic Dancer For Teandeeze.

This bitch got the nod on her beautiful head. She has a true Boxer expression with a nice dark eye shape, correct stop and chin and a good mouth. Very soundly constructed and has an excellent show temperament. Still a baby at only 13 months but she won me over to take the RCC over some excellent bitches. One I would love to own.

2nd Allens Rattray Just Enough

Another quality bitch with a lovely head and expression. Striking outline with a long arched neck, level topline and a good rear end which helped her move out well. Still quite raw but I'm sure when she fills out could trouble the best.

3rd Wearings Miofrey Telling Tales

GB 8 (2 Abs)

1st Clarkes Clarkenwells Vogue Trader

I gave this bitch a 1st last year when she was just 6 months and what cracking bitch she has grown into. Well off for size yet retains her femininity. Good head with a strong muzzle. Imposing outline that still needs time to finish. Moves very well with good drive. Last 5 for the CC.

2nd Pyes Burnden Priceless

This was a close decision. Quality bitch with a pleasing well balanced head. Correct eye shape that gives her a lovely expression. Arched neck, strong short back with well muscled quarters. Shown in gleaming condition. Would just like a little more height on foreleg to complete the picture.

3rd Hobsons Berwynfa Bump N Grind Avec Nickerbox.

PG 16 (3 Abs)

1st Millers Walkon Atomic Kitten

Very smart brindle and white girl. Presents a clean, balanced outline with correct shoulders and front. Good topline and strong quarters. This bitch's head is a picture with feminine expressive eyes, lean skull with no excess wrinkle and a good mouth. Didn't seem to give her best today but did enough to win this good class and be shortlisted for the CC.

2nd Lockwood –Brown & Curtis Shiloh Danish Pastry.

Very similar to 1st. Smart outline with good bone and substance, level topline and shown in excellent hard condition. Moved with drive. Pleasing head and expression but just preferred the cleaner skull of 1st.

3rd Downings Stellvana The Temptress

LB 15 (2 Abs)

This class was so difficult as the first three had all won classes last time I awarded CC's.

1st Mairs Glenauld Trinity JW

Have always loved this bitch, she is a pleasure to go over. Stylish and balanced without any exaggeration. Very good head with kind expressive eyes. Arched neck, strong short back, excellent quarters and moves out really well. Won this class on her overall type but would like her to carry a little less weight. Shortlisted for CC.

2nd Pynegars Berwynfa Doll-Daga-Buzz-Buzz JW

Its hard not to sound repetitive but so many of the same comments apply. A striking bitch with a good head, nice eye, correct stop and evident chin. Elegant outline that flows throughout, shown in top condition and moved very well.

3rd Beardsell & Van Becks Newlaithe Just Stunning

OB 7 (2 Abs)

1st Martin & Parkers Ch Olleyville Rosina Brown

As soon as this bitch enters the ring she demands your attention and I loved what I saw. She oozes style and quality and presents a breathtaking outline. True front, good bone. Long arched neck that's flows into a strong level topline and finished with well muscled quarters. Her head is clean with no exaggerations and has a nice eye and good mouth. Gives her handler 110% and they make a great team. Moved with drive and never put a foot wrong. BIS over an excellent male with agreement of my co judge.

2nd Cunninghams Ch Hamlear Hail To Glory

Very similar bitch to 1st. Lovely head and expression with good balance of muzzle to skull and correct dark eyes. Very sharp outline and moves out well but not with the verve of 1st but a worthy champion.

VB 5 (3 Abs)

1st Box & Turners Boxken Bitter Beer

This bitch didn't look out of place in the line up. The years have been very kind and she looked more like a 3 year old. Lovely head and her body is still in super condition. Showed her socks off to take BVIS over her brother.

2nd Wraggs Harmour Internet Trader

R&W bitch again not showing her age. Her head is still clean and only a few grey hairs. Well toned body, moved very well and seemed to be enjoying her day out.
