

NORTHERN BOXER CLUB LIMITED SHOW held at BIRCOTES, DONCASTER on 5th OCTOBER, 2008

This was a show I will never forget, as within a mile of the venue, someone smashed into my car and it was written off. Thankfully, no one was injured and I arrived at the venue a little shaken but all in one piece. My Best in Show winner was Pynegar's BERFYNWA G FORCE and as I said later – what a day, it started with a big bang and finished with full on G Force – just my strange sense of humour. In Reserve spot was another striking male, Beardsall and Van Beck's NEWLAITHE ON TARGET JW. Best puppy went to Naylor's ROCKET MAN AT RIKIDEE. My sincere thanks to the officials and committee for looking after me so well, especially first thing in the morning.

MPD (4,2)

1. Naylor's **ROCKET MAN AT RIKIDEE**. Just at the right stage for his age this smart 6 months pale Brindle and white pup has very clean lines all through. His head is nicely chiselled with good stop with a nice dark eye, giving such an appealing expression and very good mouth. He has good bone in a well-assembled front set-up with the corresponding neat run in to good body proportions. Nicely muscled hindquarters for his age and he is a steady mover who has been well schooled. Best Puppy
2. Cairns' **GALICAR INTRUSION**. Dark Brindle and White of 8 months with a well-balanced skull with nice well-shaped dark eyes. Just a shade high on the leg at this time but this may change with maturity. He has a good body shape with nicely balanced rib to loin ratio. Not so positive in rear movement as winner nor in depth of chest.

JD (5,1)

1. Fielding's **MIMATELI BOBBY BUSTA**. This rusty brindled young man is 14 months and has a very well-balanced skull with a nice dark eye and a good bite. He has a good front with well-boned legs but his feet let him down a shade. He has good depth and tuck up with good rib to loin ratio and nicely muscled quarters with a well set-on tail. A nice steady mover he was true both coming and going and his handler got the very best out of him.
2. Booth's **SELTAP EGO FRIENDLY**. This red brindle was also 14 months with a good outline. He possesses a nicely balanced head, if a shade wrinkled, but with a good eye and a nice run in to what is a rather upright shoulder placement. He has, however, good bone and feet. He was not so positive in movement as 1.
3. Fairbrother & Madin's **VANECK HAUSMEISTER WEIN**.

ND (2)

1. Fielding's Mimateli Bobby Busta.
2. Boardman & Dawson's **BONOBO FIRST ISSUE**. Upstanding dark brindle male just a shade wide in the front but with good bone. He has a nice run in to the shoulders but does rise a bit to the rear. Quite erratic on the move on this occasion.

GD (5,1,)

1. Beardsell & Van Beck's **NEWLAITHE ON TARGET JW**. Nicely put together this red brindle male just out of Junior. His head has lovely parallels with lovely stop, balancing the skull and foreface spot on. He has a lovely expression from a well set and correct shaped eye and a good bite. He has a lovely short back with good depth to his chest and a lovely lay of shoulder with good bone and neat feet. His ratio of rib to loin are very good and he has excellent muscle tone in his quarters. He moved round the ring in total accord with his handler and I was splitting hairs in the final decision for Best Dog. **Reserve Best Dog and Reserve Best in Show**.
2. Cobb's **STANRYK DREAM RYDER**. Just slightly longer cast than winner this young man has a lot going for him. He has a very nice skull with good stop and strong foreface. Nice dark eye and good bite. He has a good neck and nice run in to well placed shoulders with good bone in the front legs. Nice depth to his ribcage and he is well-muscled allowing free-flowing movement. Well handled, he did everything that was asked of him.
3. Barrand & Royle's **NEWLAITHE RAISE MY GAME FOR SIACYBOX**.

PGD (2,1)

1. Chippendale's **MOREMAYHEM FOR MYLICAM**. This 2-year-old red has a good outline and moves very soundly and steadily. He possesses a nicely balanced skull with good parallels and clean lines. He has a nice dark, well-shaped eye and a good bite. A very nice front assembly with smooth run in to a nice short back with good rib to loin ratio. Very well muscled at the rear allowing his free flowing movement.

OD (3)

1. Pynegar's **BERFYNWA G FORCE**. As his name suggests a strong well-balanced male with lovely parallels in a beautifully balanced skull and foreface, well-set ears and lovely dark eye giving that typical Boxer look. Good dentition with plenty of strength in the under-jaw. He has a beautiful run-in to an excellent front assembly and his extended reach in front movement set him apart from the rest covering the ground with such ease and precision. He has lovely depth to the strong ribcage, correct slope to the rear and his rib to loin ratio is just right to give him that required square look. He is very well-muscled in the rear giving such power to his hind movement, which was true at all times. He was handled to perfection and did not put a foot wrong throughout the day. **Best Dog and Best in Show**.
2. McArdle's **PRINGHAM SMOKEY JOE AT McARMADALE**. Another upstanding brindle male with great ring presence. He has a well-balanced skull with lovely stop and strong muzzle. Nice dark eye and good dentition. He has a lovely neck and a good set of shoulders with excellent bone. His body proportions are spot on and he has nice depth and good rib to loin ratio. He is very well-muscled in the quarters and I was disappointed that he tended to move closer at the rear than I would have expected. Another extremely well-handled exhibit in total accord with his handler.
3. Beardsell & Van Beck's **MAGICAL TRICK FROM NEWLAITHE**.

MPB (3)

1. Cairns' **GALICAR INTOXICATE**. Just 8 months this sweet-headed brindle/white has the most endearing expression – that “you do want to take me home” look. She has a lovely clean skull and nice dark eye and with very good dentition and well developed under-jaw. She has a lovely reach of neck and a very good front assembly running in to a lovely body shape, nice and square. She is at the right stage of muscular development for her age and moved soundly in the class, though at the end of the day I felt she was getting a bit tired and did not move so positively and effortlessly in the final puppy challenge.
2. Fairbrother & Madin's **VANECK IMMER GUCCIS DESIGN**. Taller red bitch than the first and a shade flat in her top-line. Nice head with good parallels and stop, good bite and nicely developing under-jaw. She has good bone in the front legs though her feet could be tighter. Nice body ratio rib to loin and nice muscle developing in the quarters. She moved steadily though not with the freedom and positivity of the winner.
3. West's **SCARLET DIDDY DIVA** .

PB (4,2)

1. Pynegar 's **BERFYNWA ZA ZA ZOOM**. A lovely dark brindle/white puppy bitch with a very beautiful headpiece. Lovely parallels in the balance of skull and foreface with a lovely dark eye and a correct mouth with good strong under-jaw. She has a lovely neck flowing into nicely angulated front assembly with good bone and neat feet. She has a very short back with good strength through the rib and loin. A sound steady mover she covered the floor with ease. Lovely exhibit.
2. Turner & Watkinson's **FAERDORN HOT TOPIC TO HAYSTACKS**. Slighter built dark brindle but in proportion. Nice head and expression with nice dark eye. Just a shade upright in shoulder but with good bone though her pasterns could be firmer. Nice body shape and tuck up with developing muscle in her quarters. Felt she could be a slow maturer and time should make a difference. A sound mover she did everything her handler asked of her.

JB (2)

1. Poole & Mostacci's **FAERDORN COULD IT BE MAGIC**. Just coming up 14 months this brindle youngster presents a lovely square outline with a nice slope to the rear. Very nicely chiselled head with good proportions to skull and foreface, nice dark eye and good dentition. Well-laid shoulders and good bone in front legs and neat feet. The body proportions of rib to loin are very good and she has very good muscle-tone in well-developed quarters. She moved soundly both ends both coming and going.
2. Marshall-Curtis's **MARCURT MADE FROM LUST**. A shade longer cast than 1 this dark brindle was not so strong in top-line. She has a nice enough head with dark eye, a nice neck and nice bone in the front legs. She has a good tuck up but was not so good in rear angulation nor as positive in movement as winner.

NB (4,1)

1. Pynegar 's **BERFYNWA DOLLY ROCKER**. I could virtually repeat what I said about her litter-mate, winner of Puppy Bitch as they are, apart from Dolly being a shade darker brindle, in construction and type, very alike. In the puppy bitch challenge I felt she had just that more melting expression – another “take me home” look that swung the verdict. **Best Puppy Bitch**.
2. McArdle's **BERFYNWA BE MI BABY AT McARMADALE**. This 4-year-old dark brindle has a good head with balanced proportions and nice dark eye. She possesses a good strong neck running into a nice front assembly with good bone. She has a very solid body and a good pair of nicely muscled hindquarters. She moved steadily and soundly. Well handled.
3. Brunton's **DALTAMIE MISS TYQUE** .

GB (7,1)

1. Gilmour's **SANDYNE EXOTIC DANCER FOR TEANDEEZE**. Presenting a lovely square shape with a nice slope to the rear, this dark brindle possesses a balanced skull with good parallels and dark eye. She has a good mouth with nicely padded muzzle. Her lovely neck runs in to a very well-laid shoulder placement and she has good bone in the front legs. Her rib to loin ratio is good and she has well-muscled quarters. She moves well both ends and was very well handled.
2. Boardman & Dawson's **WALKON TANTRUMS 'N TIARAS AT BONOBO**. Slightly longer cast than 1 this junior bitch has a lovely headpiece with nice dark eye and good dentition. She has a nice neck and good run in to a shade upright set of shoulders with well-boned legs and good feet. Her top-line was a bit variable at times but she was a sound steady mover.
3. MacKay's **BERFYNWA SEX KITTEN**.

PGB (10,1,)

1. Hobson's **BERFYNWA BUMP 'N GRIND AVEC NICKERBOX**. Presenting a good square outline this red brindle 3 year old has a well-balanced skull and foreface with dark eye and good bite. Lovely neck and run in to good shoulder placement with nice bone and neat feet. She has a shade too much white in places which detract somewhat from the overall pleasing picture. She has good muscle-tone in well-turned quarters and is a sound and steady mover both coming and going.
2. Boardman & Dawson's **Walkon Tantrums 'N Tiaras at Bonobo**.
3. MacKay's **BERFYNWA.BISH BASH BOSH AT CALJAN**.

OB (5)

1. Carter's **SUSANCAR TRUDY ZYNA**. Stylish red bitch just over 2 years old with a beautifully balanced head with spot on parallels and so clean cut. She has a nice toning eye, good bite and strong under-jaw. A lovely sweeping neck, which runs into a very good front assembly with good bone, correct pasterns and neat feet. A nice depth of chest and neat tuck up presents a square and elegant profile with that essential slope to the rear. She possesses very good muscle-tone in nicely turned quarters and when on the move covered the floor area with ease. As always put down in tip top condition and so unobtrusively handled it was a pleasure to make her **Best Bitch** on the day.
2. Boardman & Dawson's **JIMBREN WONDERLUST AT BONOBO**. This eye-catching 4-y-o brindle bitch also presents an equally square and elegant profile. Again a very well-sculptured head with correct parallels and a lovely dark well-set eye. Lovely clean neck running into a really good set of shoulders, front legs well-boned and straight. She has a well-developed chest with nice slope to the rear, a strong loin and very good muscle-tone in well-turned quarters. Another lovely bitch it was a pleasure to watch on the move. **Reserve Best Bitch**.
3. Taylor's **KREUSEVINT DANCING WITH NEWLAI THE**.

Bob Cross, Judge
