Minor Puppy Bitch. 25 (7abs)

A lovely class to start the day, unfortunately, a lot of promising puppies had to go cardless.

1st. Miller's Walkon Casino Royale

Br/wh. of almost 7 mths. Short square outline with good angulation both ends. Very pretty head, excellent mouth, correct shaped eye giving a mischievous expression. Good bone & tight feet. Very good movement for a youngster. Lovely outgoing temperament. A star in the making. BBP.

2nd. Clark's Clarkenwells Vogue Trader

Br/wh. of nearly 9 mths. Taller than 1 but another lovely outline. Arched neck leading into well placed shoulders. Good head and mouth. Went well on the move.

3rd. Taylor's Kreusevint Dancing with Newlaithe

Puppy Bitch. 18 (3abs)

1st. Groves & Hare's Verileas Moonlight Mist at Jimbren.

Well grown br/wh of 11 mths. Very stylish outline, long crested neck leading into well placed shoulders. Firm topline. Good head and mouth, sweet expression. Very sound on the move.

2nd. Carter's Susancar Courtney Act

Smart br/wh of 10 mths. More compact than 1. Balanced front and rear, level topline. Straight front, tight feet. Very pretty head with good mouth. Moved well.

3rd. Watson's Roylark Pussy Galore

Junior Bitch. 13 (5abs)

1st. Mackay's Berwynfa Bish Bash Bosh at Caljan

Upstanding br/wh of 16 mths. Good head and mouth, alert expression, crested neck leading into well placed shoulders, evident forechest, good depth of brisket, well spring of ribs, correct tuck-up. Firm level topline and correct tailset. Strong angulated quarters. Moved extremely well. Liked her a lot. Last 4 for CC.

2nd. Swansborough Toucan Talk

Br/wh of 14 mths. Square outline. Well angulated both ends. Level topline, correct tailset. Pleasing head with clean skull. Moved well.

3rd. Barrett's Wayneflele Santa Monica

Yearling Bitch. 15 (0)

1st. Jordan's Sunvalley Sonnet JW

Tall upstanding br/wh of 20 mths. Very smart outline, firm level topline, evident forechest, excellent depth of brisket, straight front with good round bone and tight feet. Very pleasing head, good mouth and dark eye. Correct balance of muzzle to skull. Well muscled quarters which enabled her to move very well.

2nd. Hambleton's Marbelton In Ya Dreams

This br/wh of 23 mths has a beautiful head with a melting expression, excellent mouth, correct lip placement and visible chin. Good front, level topline and well muscled quarters, moved well.

3rd. Pynegar & Whiting's Berwynfa Doll-Daga-Buzz Buzz

Novice Bitch. 8 (2abs)

1st. Miller's Walkon Atomic Kitten

Very stylish compact br/wh of 15 mths. Crested neck leading into well placed shoulders with firm level topline, good depth of brisket. Strong quarters which enabled her to power round the ring. Very pretty head with correct balance of muzzle to skull, good mouth, sweet expression. Her time will come for top honours. Last 4 for CC.

2nd. Godwin's Sultash Tees Hannaur

Lovely outline on this dark br/wh. of 15 mths. with good front, evident forechest and firm topline. Pretty head, good mouth and evident chin.

3rd. Sampson's Bryndoer Start Me Up

Debutant Bitch. 4 (1abs)

1st. Jones Kevanor Precedence

Br/wh. just out of puppy with a square outline, good angulation both ends, level topline. Pleasing head with clean skull, dark eye Moved well.

2nd. Beardsell & Van-Beck's Newlaithe Game On

Upstanding r/wh of 12½ mths. Square outline, well angulated quarters. Good bone and tight feet. Typical head, dark eye, good pigmentation. Preferred the movement of 1.

3rd. Waterworth's Barwater Ifya Might

Graduate Bitch 11 (3 abs)

1st. Gilmore's Teandeeze Stripteeze

Dark br/wh. with a good outline and depth of brisket, straight front, round bone and strong level topline, well muscled quarters. Good width and depth of muzzle, evident chin, dark eye would prefer cleaner skull

2nd. Jordan's Plymbox Paper Backwriter at Sunvalley

Golden br/wh with balanced outline, arched neck leading into well placed shoulders. Correctly muscled quarters resulting in good driving action on the move. Typical head, dark eye, good mouth.

3rd. Rushton's Davnette Daisy Dodderidge

Post Graduate Bitch 9 (3abs)

1st. Barrett's Waynelete Cherryhinton

Upstanding dark br/wh with smart outline. Firm level topline, good length of foreleg, and well angulated quarters. Good head and expression. Moved well.

2nd. Anderson's Wilflo Modern Millie

Sound golden br/wh with a square outline. Correct depth of chest and firm topline. Pretty head and lovely expression. Good bone, moved well.

3rd. Peck's Enesha Mama Mia

Limit Bitch 19 (3abs)

1st. Cunningham's Hamlear Hail To Glory

Stylish br/wh with a lovely square outline, good front and depth of chest. Arched neck leading into well placed shoulders, firm level topline and correct tailset. Correct angulation on hindquarters which resulted in sound driving action. Pretty head, good mouth and evident chin. Showed well. CC and BOS.

2nd. Morison's Xandene Midnight Oasis JW

Br/wh. with a lovely balanced outline, arched neck leading into well placed shoulders, good spring of rib, nice tuck-up. Very good head and lovely expression, good mouth and well padded muzzle. Not the movement of 1.

3rd. Huckerby & Dowell's Bellchime Special Edition

Open Bitch 5 (2abs) 3 quality bitches.

1st. Ward-Davies Brown & Hutchings Winuwuk Storybook

I have long admired this bitch from the ringside and was not disappointed on going over her. Tall, very stylish dark br/wh with a lovely front. Well arched neck leading into good shoulders, firm level topline Round bone and tight feet. A lovely balanced head, good mouth, dark eye, appealing expression. Strong well angulated quarters. Moved extremely well. Just wish she had a little more enthusiasm for showing. RCC

2nd Cairns Galicar Indecesion

Lovely dark br/wh with square outline, crested neck, firm level topline, good tailset and quarters. Lovely head and expression. Moved well. Showed her socks off.

3rd. Miller's Walkon Ain't No Saint
