DOGS

Minor Puppy - 7 (0 Abs)

1st : Pynegar's Berwynfa Zero Tolerance - B/w. dog with excellent outline. Good tail set, bone and mouth. Moved with good drive and covered ring with ease. Handled to its best advantage. This was my Best Puppy In Show

2nd : Carter's Susancar Curtis Eecall - R/w dog well padded muzzle and a well balanced clean head, good bone with nice dark eyes giving a pleasing expression, moved with ease

3rd : Moore's Marbelton Jimmy Riddle at Padagan.

Puppy Dog - 4 (2 Abs)

1st : Archibald's Roseroyd Cork Popper - R/w dog with good bone, cat like feet, balanced head, strong pasterns, tail set on high. Dog's outline will benefit when he muscles up.

2nd : Thorpe's Roseroyd Streetwise Bruliz - R/w dog lacked the substance and maturity of the winner but had good bone and good rear angulation. Tail was maybe a little to long for my own personal preference.

Junior - 2 (1 Abs)

1st : Carter's Susancar Aiden Abbett - B/w dog, good bone, nice head and expression, level topline and good rear angulation. Correct feet both front and rear, good muscle tone all round solid dog.

Novice - 4 (1 Abs)

1st : Butter's Mindenwood Mr. Bojangles - B/w dog, good head with pleasing expression, good reach of neck, nice dark eyes. Well-developed bone, level topline, which it kept when on the move. Correct tail set. Good all male dog.

2nd : Ellis's Blairmont Hamish McBee - R/w dog. Preferred the 1st placed dogs outline but had pleasing head, well-padded muzzle, nice alert expression, tight shiny coat.

3rd : Longley's Bushbay The Marathon Man

Post Graduate - 3 (1 Abs)

1st : Forkin & Griffin. Mulbrae The Composer For SubrashII - B/W dog good front with chest reaching to elbows, good bone, strong pasterns, level topline and correct tail set, dog in top condition and moved with strong drive.

2nd : Taylor's Newlaithe Look at Me - R/w dog Push hard for 1st. place, nice head and expression lovely dark eyes, moved with purpose and drive. Good cat type feet, on another day these two could change places.

Limit - 3 (0 Abs)

1st : Pynegar's Berwynfa Who Dares Wins - R/w. dog handle to it best. Well-balanced dog with good deep brisket, dark eye and good alert expression, moved with ease and covered the ground with good reach in front.

2nd : Van-Beck's Newlaithe Dusty Nation - Dark b/w dog, well balanced head good reach of neck and an alert expression, chest reached to elbows, in excellent condition with good muscle tone.

3rd : Bridgeman's Marbelton Rockin' Robin For Dibrid.

Open - 3 (1 Abs)

1st : Butter's Mindenwood Cool Hand Luke - B/w. dog, all male this one and enjoyed his time in the ring, moved with good drive and really covered the ground. Well-balanced head with pleasing expression, nice dark eye. Good muscle tone correct front and good tight feet. This dog demanded to be my Best in show.

2nd : Bridgeman's Marbelton Rockin; Robin For Dibrid - B/w. dog. Good balanced head alert expression, good front and deep chest, not as well developed as my first placed dog, maybe a little weak in pastern.

BITCHES

Minor Puppy - 13 (4 Abs)

1st : Carter's Susancar Natalie Dressed - R/w dog , Compact well balanced dog, lovely balanced head and alert pleasing expression, moved with conviction and purpose. Well-developed bone with good tight feet. Pushed my Best puppy all the way and on another day the positions could be reversed.

2nd : Pynegar's Berwynfa All That And More - B/w dog, good bone pleasing head, good reach of neck and lovely cat feet, at this time did not have the overall outline of my first dog but still pushed hard.

3rd : Beardsell's Galicar Designed For Looks by Newlaithe.

Puppy - 2 (0 Abs)

1st : Pynegar's Berwynfa Fit Chick - Good bone, deep brisket, well padded muzzle. Dark eye and nice alert expression, dog had good condition, nice shiny tight coat.

2nd : Simpson & Aldham Trijacon Golden Gidget At Hilthorn - Good head, well padded muzzle, not as defined as my 1st. placed dog, well developed bone and nice tight feet, pleasing alert expression with dark eye.

Junior - 8 (3 Abs)

1st : Carter's Joy Nuzz At Susancar - B/w dog. Elegant dog with balanced head, deep chest, good bone and good angulation, stood square with correct tight cat feet, moved with drive.

2nd : Archibald's Theoben Class Act - R/w dog rather heavy set for me but had good bone and good conditioned coat, deep brisket and chest reached to elbows.

3rd : Clayforth's Tyslee Cover Girl

Novice - 4 (1 Abs)

1st : Butter's Bohan Diamond Edition At Mindenwood - R/w dog. Good outline, would have liked a little more covering of flesh, good shoulder placement, good bone and nice tight feet, level topline which was kept on the move, lovely reach of neck.

2nd : Pynegar's Berwynfa Fire Power - B/w dog, lacked the dark chevron marking, bang on tail set, level topline, lacked the outline of 1st. placed dog.

3rd : Brook's Jinnybrux I'm A Celebrity.

Tyro - 6 (1 Abs)

1st : Butter's Bohan Diamond Edition At Mindenwood -

2nd : Beardsell's Newlaithe Just Stunning - R/w dog. Good bone, laid back shoulders, tight feet well developed bone, well defined head with lovely expression, dark eyes. On another day these two will change places.

3rd : Hobson's Bruliz Eye Kandy

Post Graduate - 3 (1 Abs)

1st : Jackson's Vaneck Daiquiri - B/w dog. Elegant dog with well-balanced head and nice padded muzzle. Good mouth. Chest down to elbows . Moved around the ring with good back movement and drive. nice arched neck. My RBIS. And BOS.

2nd : Woolliss's Jinnybrux Just A Hint At Rameleon - B/w dog. Good angulation level topline and correct tail set, arched neck and deep chest. Just carrying a little to much weight and it outline suffered for it.

Open - 1 (0 Abs)

1st : Woolliss's Jinnybrux Just A Rumour At Rameleon - R/w dog Again it outline suffered for to much weight, good well balanced head and deep broad muzzle, good angulation , moved with good drive and reach.
